Session Title: Is the new OIG danger going to prove more important than HIPAA? Or will Ransom ware trump all as the new biggest threat?

Description: This program will cover the true benefit of an OIG compliance program - to help protect doctors against charges of fraud and abuse or penalties over the filing of erroneous insurance claims relative to federal payment programs such as Medicare and/or to help show DOCUMENTED good faith efforts to help you avoid engaging in unlawful conduct that involves a federal healthcare program.

Taken directly from the Federal Register the government states "the development of these types of compliance program guidance is based on our belief that the healthcare provider can use internal controls to more efficiently monitor adherence to applicable statutes, regulations and program requirements.

This program will briefly cover that a solid basic OIG program is considered to have seven components:

- conducting internal monitoring and auditing.
- Implementing compliance and practice standards
- designating a compliance officer or contact
- conducting appropriate training and education
- responding appropriately to detected offenses and developing corrective actions
- developing open lines of communication
- enforcing disciplinary standards through well-publicized guidelines
